8 - HAWKESFORDS

Part estate-agent, part gallery - beautiful artwork from local artists

7 - PRE STUDIO

The Pre Studio has regular showings of artwork from the local art club. Look out for posters for opening times

12 - THE GEORGIAN HOUSE

On the stairs and up in the orangery you'll find a stunning selection of artwork from local artists for sale

WHERE TO BUY FOOD

1 - THE FARM SHOP

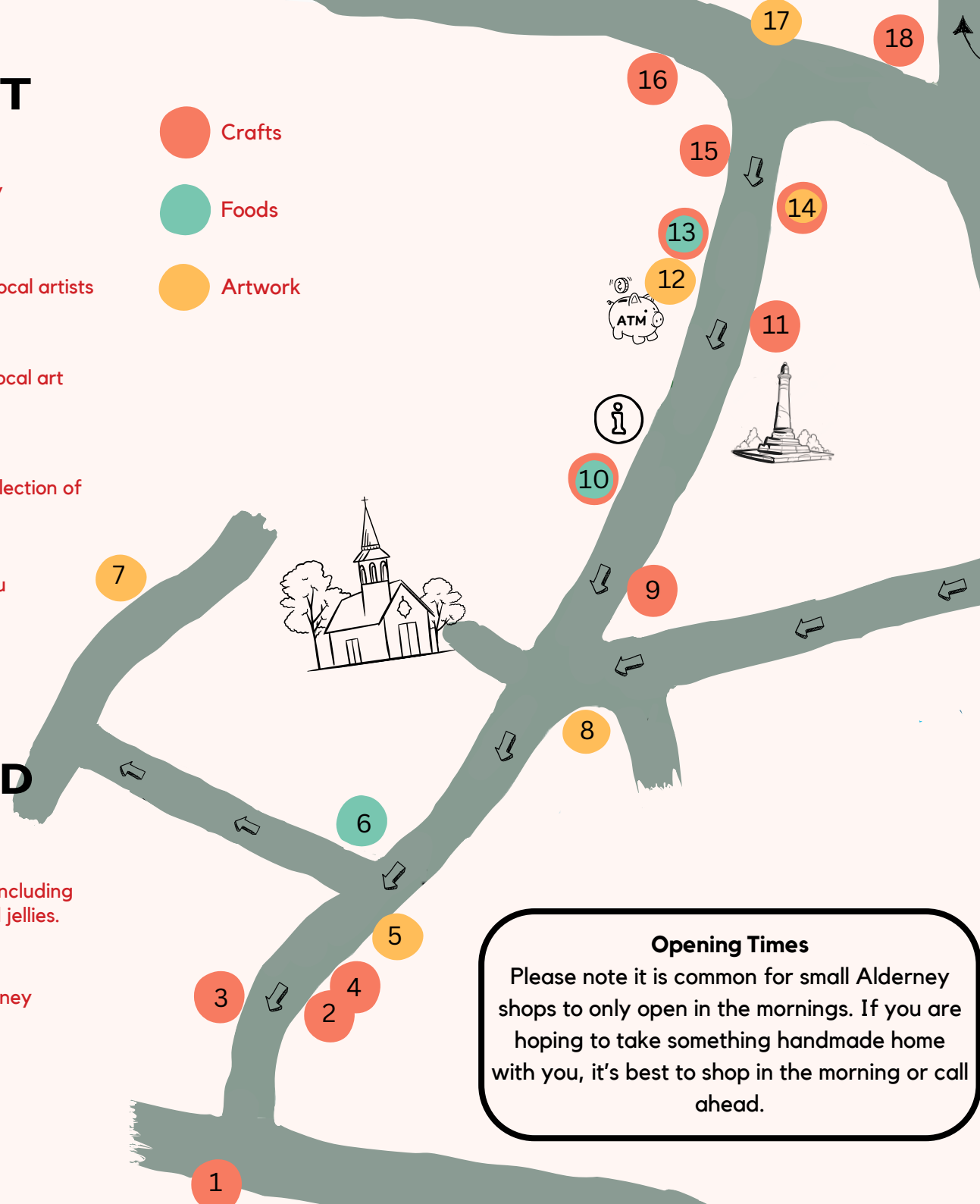
Locally-reared beef, and sometimes lamb and pork, dairy (including the famous Alderney Butter!), bread, and jars of jams and jellies.

5 - ALDERNEY WILDLIFE TRUST

Alderney honey is sometimes available from the Alderney Wildlife Trust shop

7 - ANCHORS

Anchors also stocks delicious Alderney honey!



Opening Times

Please note it is common for small Alderney shops to only open in the mornings. If you are hoping to take something handmade home with you, it's best to shop in the morning or call ahead.

WHERE TO BUY CRAFTS

1 - THE WOOL SHOP

Blankets, socks, and children's attire, all handmade locally

2 - ISLA AND ME BY THE SEA

Jewellery, clocks, and much more

3 - NORMA'S

Resin art and trinkets incorporating Alderney sand

4 - SEW MUCH FUN

Locally sewn and embroidered bits and bobs, soaps, and more!

9 - ADRIFT

Locally made pottery and designed clothes (plus, paint your own!)

10 - ALDERNEY WILDLIFE TRUST

Traditional jumpers, local pottery, feltwork, knitting, cards, and jewellery

11 - L'ESPOIR

Alderney-inspired, locally made wax melts

13 - ANCHORS

Locally made clothes and accessories

14 - LULU'S

Lulu sells local jewellery, soaps, and feltwork as well as art

15 - SARA'S

Sara has a collection of pottery from the now-closed Alderney Pottery.

16 - ALDERNEY LASER CRAFTS

You'll find a treasure trove of laser-engraved bits and bobs above Jack's!

18 - CYCLE AND SURF

Local silver jewellery and cards for sale

Near the harbour, you'll also find seaglass jewellery at London House (next to Le Cocq's), and traditional wool jumpers at Channel Jumpers. There are also lots of goodies at the airport. While exploring the island, keep an eye out for 'hedge veg' honesty stalls that often stock homemade cakes, jars of jams and jellies, and crafty bits.
